

Nomination of Ismail Jamie SC as member of the Legal Practice Council
Details of Compliance with section 7(2)(e) of the Legal Practice Act, Act No. 28 of 2014

1. **Section 7(2)(e)(i), (ii) and (v)**

The nominee has been a practising advocate for thirty years and a senior counsel since September 2002. The nominee accordingly has extensive knowledge of the matters set out in section 7(2)(e)(i), (ii) and (v) inasmuch as he has appeared in the High Court, the Labour Court and other tribunals on a regular, at least weekly, if not daily, basis throughout his career, as well as in the Supreme Court of Appeal and the Constitutional Court. The candidate has featured in some of the leading cases in the areas of constitutional and administrative law, electoral law, procurement law and environmental law, in many of them on a *pro bono* basis.

2. **Section 7(2)(e)(iii), (vi) and (vii)**

The nominee has been a member of the Cape Bar Council for approximately eight years over his career and chaired the Pupillage Committee of the Cape Bar Council for some five years. As such, the nominee is well-versed in matters such as legal education and training, the maintenance of professional standards of persons who provide legal services, and the handling of complaints in disciplinary matters. The nominee was the chairperson of the Cape Bar Council from 2012 to 2013 and from April 2018, a position which he currently holds.

3. **Section 7(2)(e)(iv) and (viii)**

The nominee has little, if any, experience in consumer affairs, and has not practised in the area of competition law.
